The 2016 cohort of students worked really hard and we are extremely proud of their results. This is the first year of the new headline outcomes 'Progress 8' and 'Attainment 8'. Our Progress 8 figure (0.41) shows that on average our students have achieved nearly half a grade more in their 8 subjects than similar students nationally. Our Attainment 8 grade (5.34) shows that on average our students achieve well above a good pass in their 8 subjects; this is the equivalent of a grade B.

This year more students have been entered for the English baccalaureate subjects and more students have achieved pass grades in all of these subjects. 38% of our students achieved a good pass in English, Maths, Humanities, Science and a Foreign Language. Last year only 23% of students managed to achieve this nationally. We continue to sustain outstanding outcomes for all students.

## Education, Employment and Training

The Department for Education reports on the percentage of pupils who go on to education, employment or training after their GCSEs. In 2014 and 2015, 100 per cent of pupils from Kelvin Hall achieved this, which was the best of all the community schools in Hull.

We are extremely proud of our achievements and we know that our very good academic standards, wide ranging curriculum and caring pastoral support contributes to the excellent prospects of our pupils. Please see below for the current destinations of our Year 11 leavers in 2016.
