We would like to remind all students that they must be ready for school as they enter the school through the Teal Line in the morning.

This includes having a bag with all the necessary equipment (pencil case, planner and conduct card), and adhering to the school dress code.

As we move into the summer months, we would like to remind you that students may wear black **tailored** shorts or a knee-length black skirt instead of trousers. All uniform rules including correct shoes (not trainers), polo shirts and sweatshirts, apply as normal during the summer term. Any caps and sunglasses need to be removed before entering the building.

Students must have the necessary uniform and equipment with them at the Teal Line. They should not need to go into the school building to retrieve their uniform from their lockers (e.g. to swap trainers).
