This trip promises not only a unique sporting experience but also educational and cultural enrichment.

**Trip Details:**

**Dates:** Departure on Saturday, 5th July 2025, and return on Sunday, 6th July 2025  
**Destination:** Wimbledon and London

**What's Included:**

- **Coach Travel:** Two days of coach travel, including pick-up and drop-off at our school.
- **Accommodation:** One-night stay at a good standard hotel.
- **Meals:** Continental breakfast included.
- **Event Tickets:** Seated tickets at No.2 Court for The Championships at Wimbledon, with access to courts 3 through 18.
