Year 11 MFL Speaking Tests

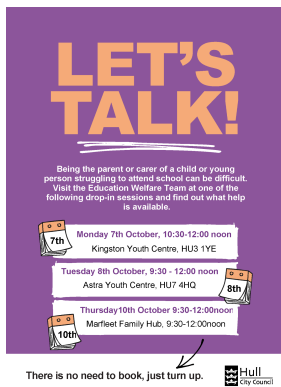

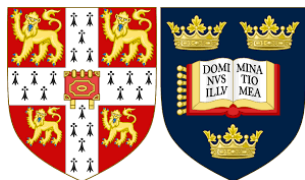
